The method of obtaining a license for medical laboratory scientist can be broadly divided into passing the examination after graduating from the Department of Biomedical Laboratory Science in Korea or the United States or passing the ASCPi examination. However, in order to work in a US hospital, English proficiency, permanent residency, or citizenship can be required as important additional factors, but the reality is very difficult. In order to do any kind of work internationally, it can be considered that English ability is one of the important things for smooth communication. The two things I can do internationally with an expected professional license in Korea are described below. First, I would like to providing indirect help to students and medical laboratory scientists studying I Korea or abroad by explaining the specific tasks of medical laboratory scientists in English using social media such as YOUTUBE or Instagram, which are essential in the on-line era. Also, I hope to increase understanding and awareness of the profession by letting people know what medical laboratory scientists do and what kind of tests they do in diagnostic labs. Second, I anticipate to experience volunteer work as a medical laboratory scientist at KOICA. After building a career as a medical laboratory scientist, I would like to apply to the KOICA volunteer group for more experience and perform various tests such as microbiological and blood tests as a medical laboratory scientist in countries such as Tanzania and Uzbekistan.
